



TLI30321 Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations (Traineeship)

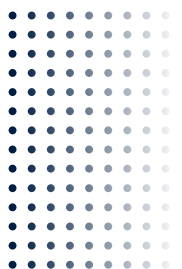

This is a qualification for those engaged in supply chain operations and includes specialisations for logistics and warehousing operations.

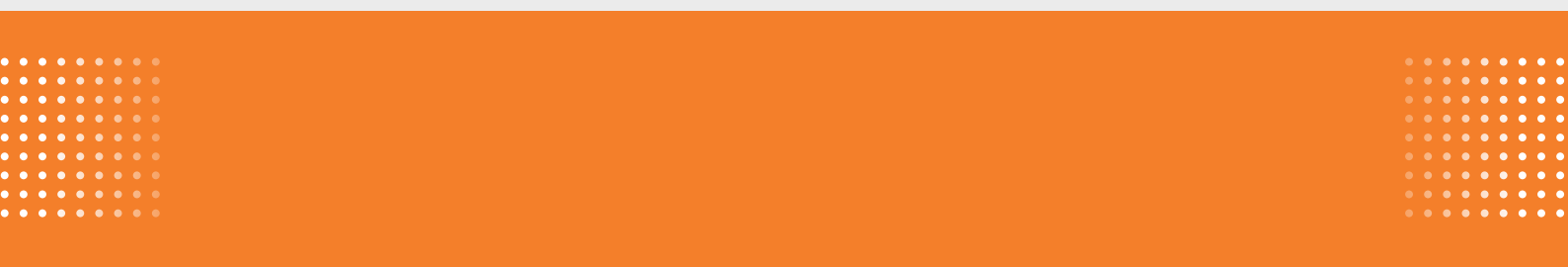
Job roles and titles vary across different sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:
