What is a Blue Card?

The Transport and Logistics Industry BlueCard is an entry-level Work Health and Safety (WHS) training program that provides the essential skills and knowledge to work safely in the transport, warehousing, and logistics sectors.

Widely recognised by employers and industry stakeholders, the program promotes safe work practices, hazard awareness, legal responsibilities, and consistent safety standards across the industry.

As transport and logistics are higher-risk industries, BlueCard training helps workers understand and apply WHS procedures to minimise risks associated with driving, freight handling, warehousing operations, and manual tasks.

iTFE (Institute of Training and Further Education), a Registered Training Organisation (RTO), delivers the nationally recognised unit TLIF0025 - Follow work health and safety procedures.

Upon successful completion, participants receive a BlueCard, demonstrating their understanding of WHS requirements and commitment to safe work practices in the transport and logistics industry. Whether starting a career or meeting employer requirements, BlueCard training through iTFE provides the knowledge and confidence to work safely and effectively.

Entry Requirements

iTFE accepts applications from domestic students. Training and assessment are conducted in English, and some assessment tasks are completed using a computer and the internet.

Standard applicants must complete the following to determine suitability:

- Applicant must have proof they have completed **TLIF0025 Follow work health and safety procedures previously**
- Applicants must provide a copy of their USI transcript
- Applicants must have or obtain a Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- Complete a short LLN assessment

- TLIF0025 Follow work health and safety procedures

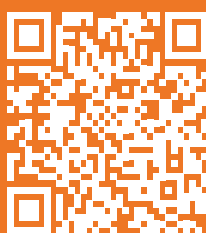
